COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY LEWIS COUNTY FISCAL COURT ORDINANCE NO. 22-03

DEMNIS

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AN AMBULANCE SERVICE DISTRICT PURSUANT TO KRS 108.105

WHEREAS, an ambulance service has not been established pursuant to KRS 108.080 to 108.180, and the Lewis County Fiscal Court, finding that there is a need for the creation of an ambulance service district in Lewis County, Kentucky,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of the County of Lewis, Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 1. An ambulance service district shall be created in Lewis County, Kentucky to provide ambulance services to all residents of Lewis County, Kentucky;
- 2. An ambulance service tax shall be implemented in such an amount as deemed sufficient, but not in excess of ten cents (\$0.10) per one hundred dollars (\$100) of full assessed property valuation;
- 3. The ambulance service district tax shall be collected by way of a special ad valorem tax for the maintenance and operation of the district and shall be used solely for the maintenance and operation of the district ambulance service.
- 4. The affairs of the district, including setting of the district's tax rate, shall be controlled and managed by a board of directors appointed by the Lewis County Judge/Executive with the approval of the Fiscal Court;
- 5. The board of directors shall consist of five (5) members and each board member shall reside within Lewis County;
- 6. Members of the board of directors shall be appointed within thirty (30) days after the establishment of the district. Directors shall be appointed for terms of two (2) years each except that initially, the Lewis County Judge/Executive with approval of the Fiscal Court shall appoint a minority of the board members for one (1) year terms. Subsequent terms shall all be for two (2) years. Any vacancies shall be

	filled by the Lewis County Judge/Executive with approval of the Fiscal Court for
	the unexpired term.
7.	The board of directors shall follow all procedures for the management of an
	ambulance service as stated in KRS 108.080 to KRS 108.180 and other applicable
	law.
